NZS 4512:2010 Fire Detection and Alarm Systems in Buildings - Clauses 216.5 & E4

## Question:

Clause 216.5 requires detectors to provide a latched, visual indication of operation. Clause E4 has a similar requirement for manual call points.

Do these clauses apply regardless of how many detectors and/or manual call points have been operated? For example, if five detectors within a zone have operated, should the visual indication be given on all five detectors?

## Interpretation issued by the Alarms and detection group

Only one detector or manual call point visual indication of operation is required per zone.

Where a circuit serves multiple zones (for example, an analogue addressable loop) it must support at least 5 such visual indications simultaneously.
